WHAT: *Katie Fehlinger Meteorologist* Joined the Eyewitness News morning team in September, 2011. She also forecasts weather on Eyewitness News at Noon. Previously, Katie had been the weekend morning news forecaster for WCBS in New York. Before coming to CBS, she was a forecaster for nearly five years at AccuWeather, Inc. in State College, Pennsylvania. While at AccuWeather, Katie served as a regular football, baseball, and hockey game day weather reporter for several regional *Fox Sports Networks*, *NESN*, *YES*, and the *Big Ten Network*. She has appeared on a host of other major networks including FOX News, FOX Business, ESPN and ABC. Fehlinger's reports brought a niche emphasis to climate change issues and the weather's effects on sports.
